

Pequannock Township New Business Procedure

All new businesses and change of ownership have to get approval through the zoning officer in order to find out whether their business is an approved business in town.

You need to file a Zoning Permit Application and CCO Application from the Construction Department.

The Construction Department goes out and does inspections on the site to be sure they are in compliance with all state and municipal regulations.

A New Business Application also has to be filed with Pequannock Township Bureau of Fire and Safety. An inspection will follow

All application will be submitted to Linda Zacharenko, Planning Secretary, in the Planning Department, 99 Alexander Avenue, Pompton Plains, NJ.
